## Suckers for Seersucker

"Seersucker Thursday" is an annual bipartisan tradition, a throwback to the days before air-conditioning was installed in the U.S. Capitol. The holiday was championed by Mississippi Senator Trent Lott

in 1996, who wanted to "bring a little Southern charm to the Capitol." Seersucker is popular in the South, but the cool, dimpled cotton fabric originated in India. The word seersucker comes from the Persian phrase shir o shekar, meaning "milk and sugar," which refers to the smooth and coarse textures of the cloth's alternating light and dark stripes.
